What the SBMS Party Book is:

The SBMS Party Book is an exciting collection of fabulous parties held throughout the school year. The actual “book” of the SBMS Party Book describes the parties, gives information about who, what, where, when, and how much a party costs to attend. SBMS families reserve the party of they want to attend on a first-come, first-paid basis at 6:00pm at the Out of Africa Auction Extravaganza on Friday, May 20, 2012. Do not be late.

How the Parties are created:

1. SBMS families dream up, or choose, and then submit the party (parties?) they wish to **host**. (see form to submit Party)
2. Party details are provided by **host**: Date, Time, Theme, Title, Location, number of persons “invited,” and any restrictions or guidelines (under 5 only, teens only, pro-surfers only, over 21 only, etc).
3. **Hosts** write a brief description of what the party is (see sample descriptions and party ideas for inspiration).
4. **Hosts** submit party ideas by **April 15th**, via email to Allwyn Fitzpatrick (allwyn@me.com).

Hosts incur all party costs so that 100% of the party ticket sales go directly to Santa Barbara Montessori School.

How do you get to go to a party?

SBMS families sign up for the parties of their choosing at the **Circus Extravaganza** on Friday, May 11, at 6:00pm. Doors open at 6:00pm. Parties are reserved on a first-come, elbow your way to the sign up sheet, basis. If there are still spaces available, families can sign up in the office beginning May 12, 2012.

NO RSVPs, no early sign-ups. Sign-ups begin at the Auction, not before.
